

How to Download & Transfer Library eBooks to a Kindle

Go to our library homepage **Bayardtaylor.Org** and click on the **download audio and ebooks** button. This will open up the **Chester County Library Systems eMedia catalog page**. The “Help/Faqs” button on the upper left side of the screen links to helpful information regarding the borrowing and downloading of audio and eBooks from the Chester County Library collection.

Browse and Checkout Titles

The eBook collections – fiction and nonfiction – are listed along the left side of the eMedia catalog page. Clicking on “**eBook Fiction**” or “**eBook NonFiction**” will open up a new set of links to the various genres within these categories (ex. – “Historical Fiction”, “Science Fiction & Fantasy”). Click on a particular collection or genre to view a list of titles in the collection.

Titles that can be downloaded to a Kindle will have the words “**Kindle Book**” underneath the book’s title along with a very small image of a Kindle. If the book is not already checked out by another patron, you will see the option to “**Add to eCart**” to the right of “Kindle Book”. Otherwise, you will see the option to “**Place a Hold**” (If you place a hold, you will receive an email when the title becomes available for you to check out).

Once you have selected a title or titles to check out by adding them to your “eCart”, click on the **Proceed to Checkout** link. Sign in by entering your **full library card number**, found under the bar code. Most titles will checkout for 7 or 14 days. Click **Confirm Checkout**.

Download Title to Your Kindle

A screen will appear showing information about the title(s) you have checked out. To download to your Kindle, click on the “**Get for Kindle**” button alongside the book title.

A new browser window will now open showing you your title within the Amazon Kindle store. Click the **Get Library Book** button on the right side of the screen, in the green box. If you were not already logged into your Amazon.com account, you will now be prompted to log in. Make sure that you log into the same account that you registered with your Kindle.

On the screen that follows, use the pull-down menu to specify which device or Kindle application you would like to have your title delivered to. Most users will see the name of their Kindle displayed and will leave that as the default destination. Now click the **Continue** button.

You should now see a **Thanks!** Page. Your checkout is complete. Your Kindle will download your ebook the next time it connects to Wi-Fi or the Amazon 3G network. Alternately you can attach your Kindle to your personal computer using the USB cable and click **Download Now**.

On your Kindle, your book will show on your Home screen as a new title.
